



Dear Sponsor:

We want to ask you to take part in the 30th Annual BASS LIFE Benefit Banquet and buy a table if possible. Your participation is crucial for this organization to continue to improve the fisheries of the Ark-La-Tex area

BASS LIFE was formed in 1993 from the original BASS RESEARCH Foundation. More than \$400,000 has been raised since becoming Bass Life Associates, Inc., with every penny staying in the ARK-LA-TEX. This annual banquet is responsible for 100% of our funding, so we are sincerely appreciative of your support.

BASS LIFE is responsible for the "Trophy Replica Programs" on Caddo and Cross Lakes, with more than 600 trophy bass over 8 lbs. weighed, certified and released alive back into the lakes. We also have expanded the Cross Lake Fish Hatchery by 21 ponds and stocked about 5,106,846 fingerlings into area lakes. Some of the other projects we have undertaken are the extension of the Earl Williamson Park boat dock on Caddo, plus the \$22,000 given to replace the damaged pier just recently damaged by high water. "Get Hooked on Fishing Program for kids, clean up of several area lakes, and assisting Louisiana and Texas Wildlife & Fisheries Departments and supplying a GPS unit for every game warden in the ARK-LA-TEX, provided \$2,000 support for P.O.I.N.T., a special fishing tournament for the handicapped. We provided \$30,000 for the Northwest Wildlife & Aquatic Education Program for 5th graders in seven parishes. We have donated \$1500 in the past 3 years to the Northwest Autism Chapter to sponsor Camp Rainman on Lake Bistineau.

For the Texas Wildlife Department, we funded a tagging survey over a 3 year period and funded a channel marker renovation project for \$13,000 on Caddo Lake in LA and TX.

Starting in 1998, we have stocked Lake Bistineau with about 979,522 Florida Bass fingerlings and have hopes that Lake Bistineau will become the "Premier" bass fishing lake in Louisiana.

Some Completed Projects include: Buying and equipping a trailer with insulated tanks and a barge designed for transporting bass fry, also to be used as a catch and release barge for major Bass tournneys.
